


PONDER & PLAN


Finally, wall color and lighting play vital roles in completing the aesthetic, from relaxing to energizing to simple comfort.








DECKS & PATIOS



Raise a glass to the great outdoors with the addition of a bar. This can be a stylish place to gather, converse, and quench thirst.


An outdoor bar can be encased by tile, porcelain, or stone. Each carries characteristics – color, texture, size, and shape – which give the space a touch of finesse. Whether part of the bar wall, adjoining columns, or underfoot, they are each a satisfying choice.




POOLS





The yard is not immune from upgrades that enhance its appeal. By introducing artificial grass or pavers, or both, landscaping can usher in a new realm of interest.


